**Proofs of residency will be needed in case we go forward for a formal assessment. Please see backside for documents needed.**

**A photo ID plus these documents are required for any new student enrollment or to file a change of address. A birth certificate is needed.**

TWO of the following documents (items cannot be from the same category below):

1. A Utility Bill (not water or cell phone) dated within the past 60 days
2. A Deed, Mortgage Payment dated within the past 60 days, or Property Tax Bill dated within the last year
3. A current Lease, Section 8 Agreement, or [BPS Landlord Affidavit](#)
4. A W2 form dated within the year or a Payroll Stub dated within the past 60 days
5. A Bank or Credit Card Statement dated within the past 60 days
6. A Letter from an Approved Government Agency\* dated within the past 60 days

***\*Approved government agencies:*** *Departments of Revenue (DOR), Children and Family Services (DCF), Transitional Assistance (DTA), Youth Services (DYS), Social Security, any communications on Commonwealth of Massachusetts Letterhead.*

*This residency policy does not apply to homeless students.*
